To that end, please save the date for our District Meeting, scheduled for Saturday, August 20th at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will be at St. Peter, 6899 Smoky Row Road, 43235 in the McEwan Center gym where the State Tour was held. We will have a combined meeting with Districts 36 and 37, which will give you an opportunity to meet even more brothers to learn best practices to achieving goals in activities and membership.

As I shared with you on my visit, our Worthy State Deputy, Mark Siracusa, has challenged all Districts to host a monthly Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity. The idea would be each Council takes a different month to host the Exemplification, so each council would have at least two opportunities to host. Please discuss this at your program meeting.

As you are finalizing plans for Faith Programs, please include the St. Joseph Icon program that will be in the District March 5 – April 1, 2023. The Icon will only be here for 4 weeks, and March 5 – 9 is already reserved for Council 11208.

Officers Online

Brothers in certain roles should have received an invitation to Officers online for access to a wealth of information for each Council. The following positions should be able to access Officers Online; GK, DGK, FS, Treasurer, Advocate and Membership Director. If you are in one of these roles, and are unable to access Officers Online, please let me know.

Office of Youth Protection – Safe Environment

Under Faith in Action, certain Council officers/directors are required to take safe environment training and may also be required to provide authorization for a background check. These brothers need to be compliant within 30 days or are subject to removal from these roles.

Training is required for GK, Program Director, Family Director and Community Director. Background checks are required for the Family Director and Community Director. Members in these roles are required to renew their compliance with the requirements every three years, and the status of each brother in these roles can be found at Officers Online. For more information about the Safe Environment program, as well as a training for all Brother Knights, go to koc.org/safe.
