# Terms and Conditions

1) **RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS:** A deposit of \$300 per person, an insurance form (if available) and a signed Passenger Reservation Form Contract are required in order to secure a reservation. We accept telephone reservations. Please note that reservations are accepted on a first come – first served basis. We calculate our trip costs based on minimum number of passengers, as specified in the trip itinerary. We must receive full payment for the tour no later than 90 days prior to the tour departure date. In case of a cancellation, cancellation charges will be applied as set forth in these conditions, if full payment is not received 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour. Reservation received less than 60 days prior to the departure date of the tour will be subject to a \$100 late fee and must be paid in full, depending on availability. Payments can be made by a check, money order, cashier check, or credit card. Personal checks will not be accepted within 25 days of departure date. Reservations are not accepted 25 days or less before departure.

2) **TOUR PRICES:** Trinity Tour Travels accepts Checks/Money Orders/Credit Cards. If credit card companies raise their fees, this discount might change accordingly. There are no discounts for sales made on any credit cards. Trinity Tour Travels accepts Visa, MasterCard and American Express for all services. Credit card payments may also be submitted over the telephone upon customer's consent. By signing this reservation contract, the customer grants permission to Trinity Tour Travels to charge his credit card for the travel services described in this reservation contract and on the customer's invoice. Customer agrees to make all payments as stated in their invoice. **NOTE:** in case of human or computer error, Trinity Tour Travels will re-invoice the customer for the correct price or service. Trinity Tour Travels will refund passengers (less insurance fee and penalties) who choose not to pay an increase, provided Trinity Tour Travels receives a written cancellation letter within five days of the price increase notification.

3) **ROOMS:** Prices are based on double occupancy. Occasionally, double rooms might not be available. In this case, Trinity Tour Travels will reserve triple rooms with no reduction of price. Single rooms are available at a supplementary cost as stated on individual itineraries. In case we are not able to find a roommate for the passenger, the passenger will be required to pay the single supplement. Trinity Tour Travels strives to give sufficient prior notice to any room changes regarding double occupancy versus single supplement. Please note that some countries or hotels do not offer triple rooms. Hotel rooms are provided based on availability and could not be specifically requested in advance.

4) **TAXES:** Airport Departure Tax, Port charges and Fuel Surcharges are added to the price of all tours. Additional fees may apply upon changes to the above items.

6) **INSURANCE:** Insurance is not included in the tour price. Trinity Tour Travels highly recommends the travel insurance package, which is offered. Insurance is not effective until payment is received by Trinity Tour Travels or by the insurance company. Trinity Tour Travels does not accept responsibility for any loss or expenses, which the passenger or anyone may incur as a result of failing to secure adequate insurance coverage. Insurance fee is refundable within 7 days of premium payment. Insurance premium is based on package cost. Please note that the insurance is a Group Insurance, therefore, individual names will not be found when calling the insurance company.

7) **MEDICAL CONDITION:** While Trinity Tour Travels strives to provide the highest level of service to all passengers, it is the passenger's responsibility to arrange for special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers if required. Please note that not all sites are handicap accessible. Trinity Tour Travels are not responsible for any medical conditions that occur during or prior to the tour.

8) **CANCELLATION:** All cancellations must be submitted in writing to Trinity Tour Travels and must be signed by the person who made the original reservation. Cancellations are only effective once received by Trinity Tour Travels. Postmark prevails. No refunds are issued for cancellations received after the departure date of the tour. In addition, unused services will not be refunded. Penalties will apply. (See boldface print in the Responsibility and Liability section for company cancellations). In case of a cancellation, cancellation fees and penalties will be deducted from your refund. Cancellation fees are also applied to deposit checks (Airline penalties could be total cost of airline ticket.) Group tickets on airlines are non-refundable. Cancellation fees apply to each person. Refund processing time can take up to 10 weeks.

9) Travel Insurance fees are non-refundable 7 days after premium payment. Trinity Tour Travels reserves the right to cancel a tour. Penalties are not applicable when canceled by Trinity Tour Travels. Trinity Tour Travels will process cancellations claims up to six months after travel dates. After six months, any unclaimed funds will be forfeited.

10) **BAGGAGE:** Passengers are allowed to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs. and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Passengers are also allowed to bring one (1) carry on, with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" as permitted by airline luggage regulations. Please check with airline for latest regulations as any future updates will apply. Trinity Tour Travels is not responsible for passenger luggage. Passengers are responsible for notifying the airline directly for lost luggage claims.

11) **AIRLINE TICKETS:** Passengers are booked on a group ticket with stipulations and restrictions. Group tickets depart and return to one airport. Most airlines restrict deviations to group tickets. Tickets are issued about 60 days prior departure. Trinity Tour Travels uses names as written on this registration form. Name changes will result in added cost.

12) **SEAT ASSIGNMENT:** Tour flights do not have an advance seats selection, however Trinity Tour Travels will try to meet individual requests upon availability. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companion. Passengers must arrive three hours in advance arrival to departing airport. Seat assignments are controlled by the airlines.

13) **RESPONSIBILITY and LIABILITY for Flight and Passenger Accommodations and Services:** Trinity Tour Travels is responsible for making all arrangements for tour services offered in the itinerary. The airlines, hotels, land operators, and other suppliers providing services are independent contractors and not agents, employees or associates of the Trinity Tour Travels. Acceptance and confirmation of your reservation is at the discretion of the airlines even after full payment has been made. Trinity Tour Travels is not responsible or liable for the service of an aircraft, watercraft, motor coach, taxi, or other conveyance, which may be used in the performance of its duty to the passengers. All vouchers and other documents for services issued by Trinity Tour Travels are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the suppliers and to the laws of the country where services are supplied. If the tour services, as indicated by the itinerary, cannot be supplied or there are changes in the itinerary for reasons beyond the control of Trinity Tour Travels, Trinity Tour Travels will arrange for provisions of comparable services. ## DAY. 8

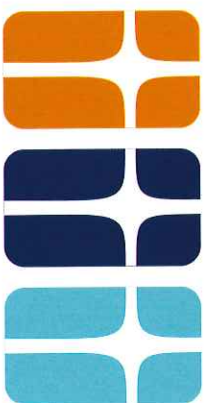

We will get to visit the Wailing (Western) Wall and witness amazing views of the Al-Aksa Mosque and Dome of the Rock. Next, we'll see the site known as David's memorial and visit the Caenaculum. The place where the Last Supper occurred & the Descent of the Holy Spirit. We'll get to walk the Kidron Valley and see the Pool of Siloam; where Jesus ordered a blind man to go to wash mud out of his eyes. We'll wrap up the night visiting St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times.

## DAY. 9

We'll start the day very early praying the Stations of the Cross as we walk the true way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa). The road will lead us to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, where Jesus was crucified (Calvary) and buried, and then rose again. View the Pool of Bethesda scene of Jesus' healing the paralytic next to the windruffled water. Travel back to the hotel to pack and prepare ourselves for the welfare dinner in Bedouin cultural restaurant.

## DAY. 10

After an early breakfast and heartfelt farewells, your group will leave by motor coach and transfer to Ben Gurion airport for your return flights home. Taking with you all the unforgettable memories that you'll cherish for the rest of your life.

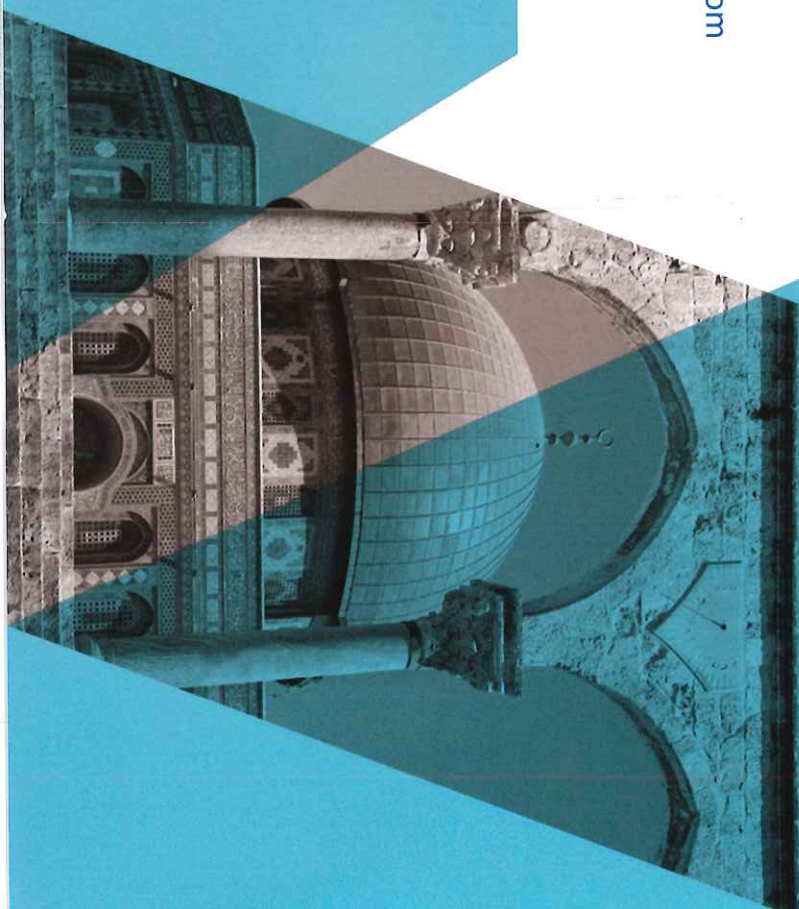

## DAY. 1

Depart United States for Tel Aviv . Make your way to your local airport where you will board your overnight flight. Your meals will be served on board.

## DAY. 2

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. Upon arrival collect your luggage in the baggage claim area and follow The signs to the "Groups Assembly Exit" where you will be greeted by your tour escort and driver. You will sleep in Nazareth on your first night.

## DAY. 3

Begin the day in Nazareth at the Basilica of the Annunciation. The Grotto, the home of the virgin Mary. Then, we will walk to the Church of St. Joseph's. After that we will head to the actual site where Christ had performed his first miracle in Cana. Our staff will have a surprise for all the couples there!



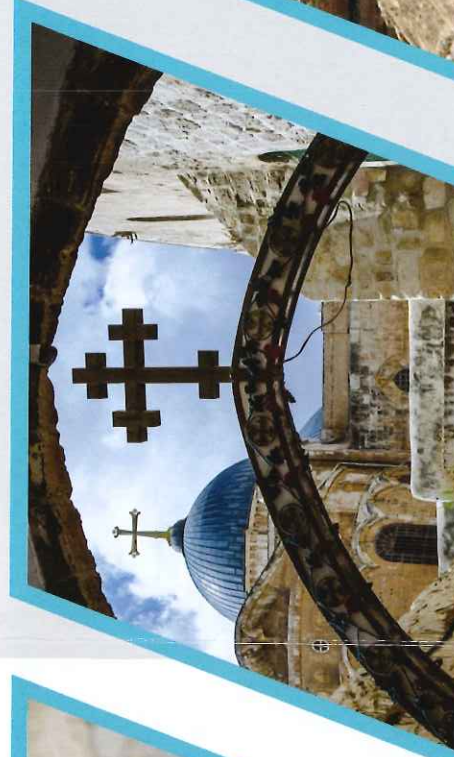
In the afternoon we'll climb Mt. Tabor; the site of the Transfiguration of Jesus. You will stand where Peter, James and John stood and see the view of where the Glorified Lord with Moses and Elijah appeared. We will celebrate a thanksgiving mass there.

## DAY. 4

Begin the day traveling to the Sea of Galilee. We will visit the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the mount is remembered. Travel to Tabgha; best known for the miracle of the multiplication of loaves and fishes. Tabgha stands on the site of a 4th-century church, displaying a beautiful Byzantine mosaic decorations that are among the most elegantly executed in the Holy Land. After that we will take a memorable boat ride across the lake where Jesus walked also known as the Lake of Genesareth or the Sea of Tiberias. We'll have lunch & continue on to the Church of Peter's Primacy (where Peter declares his love for Jesus three times). Holy Mass will be celebrated there. Then on to Capernaum to see the spectacular ruins of the ancient synagogue. You will visit the Catholic Church that hovers over St. Peter's house then head back to the boat for another beautiful ride across the Sea of Galilee.

## DAY. 5

We will be checking out of the hotel and departing for Caesarea Maritima, the old capital of the Roman Province of Palestina Prima. We will see the Roman and Crusader ruins, along with the Harbour where St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. We'll continue on to Haifa where we visit Mount Carmel and the Cave of Elijah. The place where he had lived and hid before his fateful encounter with the priests of Baal. From the top of the Carmel mountain you will enjoy a breath taking view of Haifa port and the Mediterranean sea.



We'll visit Bahai Gardens; the most visited distinct tourist attraction in all of Haifa. We'll finally have the opportunity to do souvenirs shopping right before we end the night with an amazing dinner at our hotel in Bethlehem.

## DAY. 6

Start a wonderful day in Bethlehem by heading to Church of the Nativity. We will go below it to enter the cave-stable of Jesus' birth. Holy Mass will be celebrated where St. Jerome translated the bible into Latin.

After lunch we'll drive to the town of Beit Sahour and visit the Shepherd's Fields, inhabited by Christians for hundreds of years. In the afternoon we'll visit Ein karem the birth place of John the Baptist. We'll visit the visitation church where our blessed mother visited her cousin Elizabeth. Then after that we'll head to Rosary Sisters (The first Palestinian congregation) founded by Saint Marie Alphonsine Danil Ghattas who was canonized by pope Francis.

## DAY. 7

Early morning we'll travel to the real site of Jesus' Baptism by the Jordan River where we will renew our baptismal vows. Afterwards we'll take the Jordan Valley to get to Jericho to celebrate mass there. (The oldest city in the world). We'll climb Mt. of Temptations onward to Qumran where they found the dead sea scrolls. Finally, we will have one of a kind experience in the Dead Sea. The saltiest & deepest hypersaline lake in the world.
