MESSAGE FROM FR BROWN

One of my favorite images within this season is probably the image of fire. Not simply because I find it enjoyable during cold weather, but because fire is a beautiful symbol within Advent itself. A couple of weeks ago, we heard in the Sunday Gospel from John the Baptist that Jesus will baptize "with the Holy Spirit and fire," while also we hear in Matthew's Gospel that it was by a rising star in the sky (i.e. a ball of fire) that the Magi were able to travel to find the Christ child.

There's three ideas that come to mind when relating fire to our Christian faith:

- 1) The idea of illumination Just as a fire lights up a dark room, so does the Holy Spirit within our souls; most especially through the gifts bestowed at Baptism and Confirmation, but also through the supernatural virtues of faith, hope and charity.
- 2) The idea of warmth Sitting in a cold, dark room, not only is one shivering, but often times there's an accompanying feeling of loneliness. Christianity is the religion of the enkindled heart. We were never meant to be alone and when we allow Christ into our lives, He enkindles the heart with warmth and comfort. Such must have been the feeling of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph at the birth of Christ even with the limited accommodations and the life-threatening situation of Herod surrounding the birth of Christ.
- 3) The idea of purification A purifying flame burns away the false and leaves behind the true and just as fire strengthens and purifies metal, so is the case with the soul plagued by sin. Opening the heart to the love of Christ when in need of mercy and forgiveness leads to a burning away of the old self in order to allow the goodness of the soul to emerge cleansed and purified.

With all that said, it might be worth remembering the words that the deacon or priest reads during the Baptism of a child when the child's candle is lit from the Easter Sunday Paschal candle. He reads: "Parents and godparents, this light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly, so that your child, enlightened by Christ, may walk always as a child of the light and, persevering in the faith, may run to meet the Lord when He comes with all the Saints in the heavenly court."

Merry Christmas to you all!

May the love of God be with your families now and always.

DETAILS ON HOW WE MANAGE SNOW ON CAMPUS...

Our snow contractor only plows the lot when we reach TWO INCHES of snowfall. The parking lot is only pretreated if it is not raining (the rain would simply wash it away). The parish facilities team will be responsible for keeping the walkways cleared. When weather is cold, please be careful when walking around the campus as it may be slippery in places.

Parish activities remain open if we are at a Level 1 Snow Emergency, but people should carefully consider whether they can safely reach the campus and attend. If a Level 2 Snow Emergency is declared, the entire campus closes, including Mass. We will alert you by ParishStaq email and social media if this happens. School parents will be alerted by school communications of any school closures or delays. Faith Formation parents will be notified via ParishStaq email communication of any cancellations. The Parish Office remains open during business hours, 9 AM to 4 PM. If we reach a Level 3 Snow Emergency, the office will close.



Fourth Sunday of Advent

Is 7:10-14 | Rom 1:1-7 | Mt 1:18-24



GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In our family's department-store Nativity set, Joseph blends into the background: Mary and the infant Jesus steal the scene, she in her blue robes and looking over the sweet, tiny and vulnerable Son of God. Even the Magi stand out more than humble Joseph. Yet today's Gospel focuses on Jesus' earthly father, whom many of us Catholics grew to know a little better during the Year of St. Joseph in 2021. Imagine Joseph's shock at learning Mary was pregnant! Rather than quietly divorcing her, he accepts the angel's words at face value: "For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." Joseph takes Mary into his home and embraces her and the child Jesus she bears. As we celebrate this fourth Sunday of Advent, we can all do well to follow Joseph and Mary's example by saying "yes" to God, even though it may turn our lives upside down. We can dust off our Nativity scenes and ask the Lord to help us prepare our hearts and homes for Jesus.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

I remember our first trip to the pediatrician with our newborn. Our job as parents, he said in so many words, was to raise him so that he'd be ready to leave us at 18. As our youngest approaches that milestone, I'm having a hard time letting go. In his apostolic letter Patris Corde, Pope Francis holds up St. Joseph as an example of what it means to be a father (and I think this applies to mothers, too): "Every child is the bearer of a unique mystery that can only be brought to light with the help of a father who respects that child's freedom. A father who realizes that he is most a father and educator at the point when he becomes 'useless,' when he sees that his child has become independent and can walk the paths of life unaccompanied. When he becomes like Joseph, who always knew that his child was not his own but had merely been entrusted to his care." Joseph and Mary loved Jesus in this way, accepting that Jesus did not "belong" to them but to all of us. Whether or not we are parents, we can learn from their example, entrusting our lives and those of our loved ones to God. As St. Paul reminds us, we "belong to Jesus Christ."

ACTION "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means 'God is with us.'" As you light the Advent candles or say evening prayers this week, reflect on the ways Jesus has made his presence known to you today and give thanks.
