LENT FOCUS ON PRAYER

...Let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith. – Hebrews 12:1-2



Welcome to Lent! We are at the start of a race to get to Easter, shedding anything that keeps us from a relationship with our Lord and keeping our eyes fixed on Him to lead us through these 40 days. As we begin the month of March this week, there are several new opportunities to be supported in our Lenten race.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS are held in the church every Friday of Lent at 7 PM, led by our deacons. Walk and pray the path that Jesus walked, connecting to the story and those who played a part.

Beginning March 6, the Knights of Columbus give us the traveling PILGRIM ICON OF ST JOSEPH. This beautiful icon will be in the Adoration Chapel through March 11 to ask of his intercession. A prayer service in the church on March 7 at 6:30 PM will honor this beloved saint.

Adoration, Adoration, Adoration!! This month's theme of our year of prayer is **PRAYING IN THE PRESENCE**. The diocese gives us **40 DAYS OF ADORATION** to visit different parishes and take part in their Holy Hours. Some have made that their pilgrimage for Lent! We host the 40 Days on Wednesday, March 8. Adoration will begin in the chapel at our usual 7 AM time, then move to the church at 10 AM. **ANCHORED IN ADORATION** then happens at 6 PM with elevating music, confessions, one of our parishioners giving a testimony of faith, and our prayer team ready to pray for your intentions.

Deacon Doug Yglesias will help us learn more about Adoration and lead our LORD, TEACH US SERIES on Monday, March 20 at 10 AM and 7 PM in the chapel. If Adoration is new for you or if you just want to know more of how to pray this sacred hour, please join us. This is the perfect time to commit to an hour to fulfill your "pray" part of the pray-fast-give of Lent!

Lent would not be complete without the opportunity to shed our sins through confession. We will have our PARISH LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE on Monday, March 27 at 7 PM in the church. Many priests will be on hand to bless us with the gift of Reconciliation. If you have not been in a while, now is the time.


PILGRIM ICON PROGRAM

ST JOSEPH ICON AT ST BRENDAN!


The St Brendan Knights of Columbus Council is honored to bring the traveling pilgrim icon of St Joseph to St Brendan March 6 -11. The

ATHLETICS SCHOLARSHIP

First Sunday of Lent

Gn 2:7-9; 3:1-7 | Rom 5:12-19 | Mt 4:1-11



Superbowl Sunday was two weeks ago, and many of us were more likely interested in the commercials than the actual game. After all, companies pay a ton of money to have their products paraded in front of us, and - in theory at least - take the time to make these particular ads memorable and funny. If we can be convinced that we will be better people, or our social outings greater and filled with more laughter, we will buy what they are selling. It's the modern version of the words of the serpent in today's first reading: if you eat this, "you will be like gods"! Today's readings are a reminder that we are all sinners and burdened by being vulnerable to false promises - but also that we are relieved of this burden through one man: Jesus Christ. If we tend to forget that the most important part of our salvation story is that it is full of more grace and forgiveness than we can comprehend, this first Sunday of Lent is a good time to prayerfully ponder this. If God seems far away or distant, let us recall that he loved us so much that he breathed our very life into us, and then gave his only begotten Son to us that we might have life eternally. All he asks in return is for us to accept this gift and follow in his footsteps. Lent is the time to be mindful of grace-filled opportunities that draw us closer to God.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Let's think about these 40 days. In addition to allowing us to grow in understanding of God, this time is also an opportunity to grow in our understanding of how we can be the hands and feet of Jesus in the world and help to build the kingdom right here and now. How can we keep God at the center of our lives and resist worldly temptations to push him aside? Perhaps today's psalm can help us here: Ask for God's mercy, acknowledge our offenses, seek a "clean heart," renew a "steadfast spirit" within us, and ask God to grant us a "willing spirit" to give him praise. And remember Christ's words from the Gospel: Depend on "every word that comes forth from the mouth of God," which is love and mercy.

PRAY Pray today's psalm: "Give me back the joy of your salvation, and a willing spirit sustain in me. O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth shall proclaim your praise."




