

This April is perhaps the most sacred of months we have on our calendar this year. It begins immediately with Holy Week and Easter, gives us Divine Mercy Sunday right in the middle, then ends with the beautiful Sacrament of Confirmation for our eighth graders, a reminder to all of us of the gifts and grace of the Holy Spirit.

**OUR YEAR OF PRAYER THEME THIS MONTH is Lord, Teach Us How to Trust.** Holy Week and Easter are our first examples of trusting that, despite the horrific death that Christ endured, He is risen and promises the same for us. There is no better time to bring our own sufferings to Him, knowing and trusting that He who has endured more than we can imagine has paved the way for us. Our suffering unites with His in redemption and His faithful promise.

**SPEND SOME TIME WITH JESUS THIS WEEK** to pray for trust in His plan for us. Accompany Him as in the Garden by attending an hour of **Adoration** – **special extended hours until midnight during Holy Week** – to encourage us to just be with Him. **ANCHORED IN ADORATION** this month is on Wednesday, April 12 at 6 PM with elevating music, one of our parishioners giving a testimony of faith, and our prayer team ready to pray for your intentions. # MAKING CHRIST PRESENT

### A MESSAGE FROM DEACON DOUG YGLESIAS

The Jewish faith has the "mitzvah of sippur yetziyat Mitzrayim." This is the requirement of followers of their faith to not only remember the events that occurred during the Passover but during the celebration to "relive" those events. This is to make present again the events that took place during the Passover.

This carries on in our Catholic faith. We are called to not only remember the suffering, death, and Resurrection of Our Lord but to relive it. His single act of love changed the course of history and our lives personally. This happens for us at every Mass. When we come to Mass, Jesus' sacrifice made on the altar is not only remembering the words of Christ but "re-presents" (makes present) the sacrifice of the Cross, because it is its memorial and because it applies its fruits. (Catechism #1366) This is what we are blessed to celebrate at each Sunday Mass. In the celebration of the Pascal Mystery, we do not only recall what happened but we relive it because that sacrifice is made present again. Just as if we were there at the Last Supper, there at the cross, and there at the Resurrection, we are there at Mass. Do we allow ourselves to open our hearts and minds and go with the same reverence we would if we were there 2,000 years ago?

As we proceed with our Lenten observances this Holy Week, let us deliberately choose to not only remember what Christ did for each of us, but let's choose to relive it in our hearts and minds. We have the opportunity to do this through so many opportunities at our parish during Holy Week: through Adoration, Reconciliation, prayer or daily Mass, each time allowing our hearts to grow closer to Our Lord.

### EUCHARISTIC MINISTER TRAINING REINTRODUCING THE CHALICE AT MASS

Bishop Fernandes has asked us to reintroduce the distribution of the Precious Blood beginning with the Mass of the Lord's Supper and is planning to re-evaluate this change at the end of the Easter season. We are seeking to re-introduce this at St Brendan beginning with the Sunday services the weekend of April 15 & 16.

To help ensure that this goes as smoothly as possible, and to address any questions that you might have, we are having a brief training session today, Palm Sunday, April 2 at 12:15 PM (following the 10:45 Mass) and Tuesday, April 4 at 7 PM. You only need to attend one session, not both. Only those who have attended one of these training sessions will be permitted to distribute the Precious Blood. We do ask that all EMHCs attend the training, even if you are not interested in distributing the Precious Blood at this time, as there are other procedural changes that will affect host distributors as well.

To ensure that we have sufficient distributors, we ask that you email our Ministry Scheduler at **MinistryScheduler@stbrendans.net** and also copy the email to **DeaconDoug@stbrendans.net** as well. Please let us know whether you would be willing to distribute the Sacred Host, Precious Blood, or both. If you didn't already respond in time to make it to the April 2 or 4 training sessions, please do so soon, in order for us to schedule you appropriately in the future.



# Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Is 50:4-7 | Phil 2:6-11 | Mt 26:14—27:66

#### GROW AS A DISCIPLE PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

As we begin Holy Week, we hear Matthew's account of the Passion. We see Jesus' humanity as he experiences *sorrow and distress* in the hours before his death. Three times, he asks the Father to "let this cup pass from me, yet, not as I will, but as you will." In our own human experience, I am guessing many of us have asked the Father to "let this cup pass" – for in addition to life's joys, we will all experience setbacks, struggles, and suffering. By example, Jesus shows us that we can turn to our Father, trusting in his will for us. Let this be a reminder in this holiest of weeks that we can bring our suffering and our doubts to the Father, knowing that the joy of Easter will come.

### GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The final words of today's Gospel [shorter version] are those of the centurion and the men keeping watch over Jesus: "Truly this was the Son of God!" Let us keep in mind this central proclamation of our faith while attending Triduum services this week. On Holy Thursday, we remember the Last Supper and the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood, celebrating Christ's outpouring of love for us. On Good Friday we venerate the cross as we solemnly recall the passion and death of Jesus. And of course at the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday, we celebrate the story of our salvation, culminating in Jesus' resurrection. As Christians, we know that the cross will give way to the empty tomb and the promise of new life in Christ. Let our voices be strong this week as we echo the centurion's words above, and may Jesus' name be praised forever!
