

### A MESSAGE FROM FR WELDIT CATHOLIC "RITE" EXPLAINED...

A rite represents an ecclesiastical tradition about how the sacraments are to be celebrated. As the early Church grew and spread, it celebrated the sacraments as would be best understood and received in the context of individual cultures, without ever changing their essential form and matter. The early Church sought to evangelize in the major cultural centers

of the first centuries A.D. These centers were Rome, Antioch (Syria), and Alexandria (Egypt). All the rites in use today evolved from the liturgical practices and ecclesiastical organization used by the churches in these cities.

According to the 1990 Code of Canons of Oriental Churches, a rite is "the liturgical, theological, spiritual and disciplinary patrimony, culture and circumstances of history of a distinct people, by which its own manner of living the faith is manifested in each Church *Sui iuris.*" (also spelled *Sui juris,* this is a Latin term meaning "in one's own right.")

The Ge'ez Rite based in Ethiopia is closely associated with the Coptic rite. Missionaries from Alexandria spread the faith in Ethiopia in the 4th century. The Alexandrian Rite is divided into the Coptic and Ge'ez Rites with the main distinction being between the Coptic and Ge'ez languages.

Ge'ez is the liturgical language of the Orthodox and Catholic Churches in Eritrea and Ethiopia. It is one of the first few ancient languages the Bible was translated into as early as the 4th and 5th centuries. In recorded history, Christianity became the state religion of the Axumite Empire (the cradle of Ethiopian and Eritrean civilization) in the 330's. In the centuries which followed, monasticism was introduced from Egypt and liturgical practices developed. Both the monastic lifestyle and the liturgical practices have made very little changes throughout the centuries.

The Ge'ez liturgical hymn (ziema) is credited to Yared who lived around the 6th century. He is known as Mahletaty Yared (which means "Yared the Composer"). The Ge'ez Christian tradition kept the liturgical dance and the drum part of its sacred ritual as part of its celebration, which is markedly African. This is a clear testimony of its unique African identity and antiquity. In Eritrea and Ethiopia, Christians make up to 50% of the total population, the majority of whom being of the Orthodox-Tewahdo tradition. Though Ge'ez is no more a spoken language, it is used for liturgical services, which can rightly call Ge'ez the sacred language of this ancient African Church. Ge'ez is an ancient court language from the period when Ethiopia first adopted Christianity. It carried down as the liturgical language even as it fell out of use otherwise and is regarded with pride as a symbol of the ancientness and rootedness of the faith in Ethiopia and Eritrea. Much like Latin in the West, many lay people do not understand the language, so several parts of the Ge'ez rite, like the readings, are in local languages.





The Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11 | Eph 1: 17-23 | Mt 28: 16-20

#### **GROW** AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Actions speak louder than words. How many of us have heard or said this exact phrase? I suspect most, if not all of us are quite familiar with this old adage. In fact, this is exactly what we are being told by Jesus himself in today's Gospel when he says, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations." Jesus continues his direction of *action* by telling us to baptize "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We are not directed to simply speak about Jesus with our families and church communities, we are told to GO among all nations and add to Jesus' flock. We continue Christ's mission when we seek to spread his love. Before Jesus joined his Father in heaven, his instructions were very clear. This is an opportunity to think about the commission we were given as part of the baptized community, and how Jesus is asking us to take action in his name.

#### GO EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

*Easier said than done.* We've all heard that one as well. It's hard to feel equipped to spread the word and the will of God. We worry our words will fail us and we will look foolish. We know we are not perfect, and wonder if that means we cannot possibly be Christ's hands and feet on this earth. However, today's reading from Ephesians provides us with the perfect prayer to give us hope and faith in the Holy Spirit as we set out to fulfill the Great Commission given to us in this week's Gospel: "May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him." We are challenged to act for God, but not without being given the tools to do so with confidence.

**PRAY** Meditate on today's second reading from Ephesians. Read it as if your priest was giving you a blessing before you head out of your house each morning. Let it fill your soul with love and awe for our Father, and let it give you the confidence you need to play an active role in building his kingdom until he comes again.
