

## **MESSAGE FROM JACOB DORAN**

### THREE FAITH FORMATION PATHWAYS

I am excited to bring news about expanding our family faith formation program to better accompany and support each family where they are in their faith journey. This past year, we offered everyone the same resource and at-church family sessions. We also added additional content and meetings for those in a sacramental year. After hearing feedback from you, family faith formation at St Brendan will begin to offer three different pathways for families.



**SEEK & ROOT** - If you are new to family faith formation, you will join the Seek and Root pathway. These families meet on Monday night at church 10 times throughout the year - twice a month in September and October, and once a month November-April.

**SACRAMENT PREPARATION** - Families returning to family faith formation and preparing one (or more!) of their children for a sacrament this year will meet on a Monday night five times through the year, in addition to sacramental celebrations. These family sessions run from October-March.

**CONTINUED GROWTH** - Families returning to family faith formation that are not preparing any children for a sacrament are part of the continued growth pathway, which meets on a Sunday morning or evening, OR Monday night 8 times from September-April.

Each of these tracks needs volunteers, too! We need catechists, aides, middle school small group leaders, and parent small group leaders. Please reach out if you have a heart for families - whether it be parents, children, or both!

I am also so excited about our new VBS program, TOTUS TUUS. We will host eight missionaries from around the Diocese of Columbus. These missionaries are either college students or seminarians who applied, interviewed, and trained for their positions. They rely on their host parishes to provide for their housing and meals during the summer. We would love for you to host them for dinner one night while they are here! These missionaries are the heart of Totus Tuus and their presence and witness fosters conversion and vocations in our youth. There are even a few spots left for the summer day camp program, so please sign up your kids for this incredible week! A few more adult volunteers who are able to spend the day with our kids would also help.

Finally, next week will be the first day for our new High School Youth Minister, KARA DAY. She has been on The Vine's core team as a volunteer for 7 years and has done much of the background administrative work for the ministry. During that time, she would use all her free time to minister to the youth of St Brendan. Now she will take on those same and more duties as the leader!

I hope you can see that at every level of working with youth and families, we are intent on walking forward with you. We want to be a part of your journey by supporting and accompanying you. God bless you and have a wonderful summer!



### **DISABILITY AWARENESS MONTH**

### KRISTEN MANIFOLD'S STORY...

Hi, I am Kristen Manifold. I was diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy at birth. Cerebral Palsy is a condition which is caused by damage or lack of oxygen to the brain at birth.

I grew up Catholic and received all the sacraments. My sisters and I attended PSR on Sundays, but my parents didn't make the effort to attend Mass. My



mother would just attend by herself. I thought I had to be "perfect" for Jesus and that He hated me because of my disability. I became a part of YoungLife Capernaum, which is YoungLife geared towards serving students with disabilities. I didn't know that Jesus actually wanted a personal relationship with me until I was a camper at Rockbridge which is a YoungLife camp in Virginia. I was involved with YoungLife throughout high school and while attending the TOPS (Transition Options in Postsecondary Settings) program at The Ohio State University.

I started meeting people that were involved with The Newman Center and Saint Paul's Outreach (SPO) at Ohio State during my second and last year in the TOPS program and met so many nice and accepting people (even with my Cerebral Palsy.) In the spring semester of 2020, the weekend before lockdown, I attended a retreat through the Newman Center called Buckeye Awakening. Buckeye Awakening helped me return fully to the Catholic faith.

My cousin and parishioner, Jennifer Maschari, introduced me to St Brendan parish. I have received love and acceptance here and look forward to talking to the priests and deacons whenever attending Mass. I enjoy telling them about my week and hearing about their lives as well. I feel so encouraged when I see others with disabilities serving or in the pews during Mass.

The Young Adult Community has been a great group to be a part of here. It is such a vibrant community and a great way to meet other parishioners around my age! I will be starting projects in the parish office as a parish volunteer and am honored to serve St Brendan in this way. Thank you for reading. God bless you and your family!

### **DIGNITY OF LIFE ACTION NEEDED**

The dignity of life is being threatened in Ohio by a proposed amendment to the Ohio Constitution that claims to recognize reproductive freedoms, but it furthers a culture of death and removes current safeguards for women. Three primary concerns about the proposed abortion amendment are:

- 1. Puts women at risk
- 2. Endangers preborn children

## Pentecost Sunday

Acts 2: 1-11 | 1 Cor 12: 3b-7, 12-13 | Jn 20: 19-23

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

As a college student, I found myself sitting near the information desk during a layover at a German airport. This was in the days before mobile phones and Google Translate. I remember being so impressed that the two young women behind the desk were able to answer questions in so many languages without missing a beat. Whether it was Spanish, French, German or English, each traveler heard an answer in their own language. I often think that must have been what it was like for the travelers to Jerusalem during Pentecost. They were in an unfamiliar place and yet God spoke to them in a way they could understand. And the beautiful thing about the Pentecost story is that it is not just relating one single moment in time. Instead, it is the start of the Holy Spirit's ministry here on earth, and in our baptism, we, too, receive the same gift of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation completes the grace we receive at baptism, since we receive a "special strength of the Holy Spirit." (ccc 1285) We, too, are given the tools to go forth and speak to others even when we are afraid they may not understand. Let us remember St. Paul's words from the second reading: "To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." And then let us go out and use those gifts for the greater glory of God.

### GO EVANGELIZE

### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The idea of evangelizing is uncomfortable for many people. Sure, it was fine for the disciples to go out and start talking to strangers, but us? No way. However, evangelization doesn't have to mean starting conversations on the street (although it can!). Instead, it might be making the sign of the cross before a meal in a restaurant, mentioning Mass when a co-worker asks what you did over the weekend, or displaying a crucifix in your home where visitors will see it. In these small ways, we can encourage others to open the door for God to "shine within these hearts of yours," as today's Gospel Sequence says.

PRAY St. Paul reminds us today that we are all "baptized into one body" and "we were all given to drink of one Spirit." In today's divisive world, it can be difficult to remember that. Let us pray for one another knowing that all Christians – even those who may annoy us – are joined together in the same body of Christ. Specifically, have as your at-the-ready prayer this week for all circumstances, the following: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.




