

# SPECIAL ELECTION IS THIS WEEK, AUG 8

The Bishop of the Diocese of Columbus, Earl Fernandes, encourages Catholics to vote "YES" on Issue 1. Voters can do so at the special election taking place on Tuesday, August 8 (early voting is currently underway). Issue 1 asks if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at

least sixty percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." Passing Issue 1 would strengthen safeguards that protect human dignity from conception until natural death in future ballots, which for us is a moral good to be encouraged. As Catholics, we are committed to confronting threats to human life and passionately promote the dignity of preborn children and their mothers. For this reason, Bishop Fernandes asks you to vote "Yes" on Issue 1.

### LIFE-SIZE NATIVITY WAS DONATED TO THE DIOCESE'S CATHOLIC MUSEUM

The historic life-size Nativity display at what became known as State Auto's Christmas Corner, 518 E Broad St in downtown Columbus, is relocating to the lawn of St Joseph Cathedral, 212 E Broad St. The donation to the diocese's Museum of Catholic Art and History from State Auto includes 80 pieces depicting the events surrounding the birth of Jesus Christ, and includes an additional \$250,000 from the insurer to assist in preserving the tradition for years to come.

"This is a joyous moment for our Catholic museum," Bishop Earl Fernandes said. "Receiving this beautiful Christian artwork that is so historic and meaningful to the Columbus community is a genuine honor, and we rejoice at the opportunity to preserve this display and bring it to the people of Central Ohio for generations to come. "Such a momentous display of a vital part of the chronicle of God's love for all people, when He humbled Himself to share in our humanity so we can share in His divinity, visibly invites us into a deeper relationship with our Lord."

The Christmas exhibit spanned almost a century, bringing visitors and Central Ohio residents of all backgrounds downtown by the thousands during the holiday season to drive past or stop with their families.



The museum, originally founded by Columbus Holy Family Church as the Jubilee Museum and Catholic Cultural Center in 1998, opened at its current location on November 9, 2021. In preparation for the Jubilee year of 2000, Pope John Paul II requested that dioceses across the world dedicate space to preserving the historical heritage of the Church and their dioceses. In response to the Holy Father's request, the museum was started as a parish project for Holy Family in their former parish school.




#### **ADOPT A FLOWER BED**

#### ST MONICA PRAYER


Dear St Monica,

# Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord

Dn 7:9-10, 13-14 | 2 Pt 1:16-19 | Mt 17:1-9

#### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

According to the dictionary definition, to be transfigured is to "transform into something more beautiful or elevated." This is what we see happening in Matthew's Gospel today: Jesus takes his closest disciples up the mountain and there he is transformed – he is transfigured – before them: "His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light." He is also joined by Moses and Elijah as a sign that he is the fulfillment of God's promises of old. Jesus completes the old covenant that God made with his people and brings us the new covenant of salvation. The Transfiguration parallels the Baptism of the Lord in that we once again hear God speaking from the heavens to say, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." But during the Transfiguration, God adds the words, "Listen to him." That's a command not just for his disciples there on the mountain but for us today as well.

#### **GO** EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In elementary school, we were often reminded to listen. I remember one teacher who made a point to impress upon our class that listening is different from hearing. It is easy to hear, but to listen, you need to take the time to understand what is being said. In his letter today, Peter is urging us to listen to the prophetic message of Jesus. He says, "You will do well to be attentive to it" and then compares doing so to being "a lamp shining in a dark place." The world today can be a very dark place, but we don't have to be content to live in the shadows. By following Jesus' example and commands, we can bring light – along with hope and joy – to our corner of the world. Sometimes that takes courage, though. It might involve making uncomfortable or unpopular choices, but Peter promises that the "day will dawn." When that happens, we will undoubtedly see the fruits of our good works in our efforts to build God's kingdom.

**PRAY** This week, let us pray in both words and actions as Jesus taught us. If the Lord's Prayer is not already part of your daily prayer routine, try incorporating it this week. Then, look for ways to follow in the footsteps of Jesus by reaching out to someone who may appreciate a phone call or a visit.
