

A MESSAGE FROM MAGGIE AGRA

THE EUCHARIST – SOURCE AND SUMMIT OF OUR CATHOLIC FAITH

Pope St John Paul II wrote in his encyclical, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* that, "The Eucharist, as Christ's saving presence in the community of the faithful and its spiritual food, is the most **precious possession** which the Church can have in her journey through history" (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia* 9, emphasis mine).

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. Without the nourishment it provides, we can do nothing! Through the years, I have been able to see the power of



the Lord in the Eucharist many times. In sudden conversions, physical and mental healings, and an abundance of grace for unexpected situations, Jesus has made known His power through the True Presence of the Eucharist! There is one story which I often reflect upon as showing the truth and power of the Eucharist.

A few summers ago, I had the opportunity to serve on program staff at Damascus Catholic Mission Campus. For those not familiar, Damascus is a Catholic apostolate largely known for its summer program, Catholic Youth Summer Camp (CYSC). As a program staff member, I ran the high adventure activities, participated in skits, and had a prayer lab, where I taught a small group how to pray.

About halfway through the summer, I had this amazing group of high school girls in my prayer lab. They were all interested in the Catholic faith, but somewhat cautious about diving in. One girl in particular, Emily, told me that she didn't believe in God at all. Yet throughout the week, I was able to witness their hearts begin to shift toward the truth and love Jesus offers. They were all asking questions related to the faith and began to open up during prayer lab. It culminated on that Thursday night, when we had Adoration. We were all sitting together and preparing for Adoration by singing praise and worship. When we heard the bells ringing, indicating that Jesus was entering the room, we began to kneel. At that moment, Emily (who didn't believe in God before) turned to me and, with a look of great excitement and delight, said, "Maggie! Jesus is coming!"

And in that simple phrase, I understood that Emily, and the rest of my prayer lab, had come to know and believe in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This encounter deeply changed them—throughout the rest of the night, they began to experience the Lord's presence in powerful ways. Although they walked into the week unsure and unconfident, they left consumed with the love of Jesus through their encounter with Him in the Eucharist. It also intensely struck my own heart with the depth of beauty found in the Eucharist. With this in mind, I invite you to ponder the reality of the Eucharist and allow it to set your heart on fire for Jesus. The Eucharist, indeed, is the most precious possession of the Church.



BIBLICAL EVIDENCE FOR THE REAL PRESENCE IN THE EUCHARIST (PART 2)

A further reason to take Jesus' words literally in the Bread of Life discourse in John 6, is that first-century Jews already had a metaphorical meaning for the language "eat flesh" and "drink blood"- namely, persecution, assault, and destruction. For example, in Revelation 17:6, the harlot is "drunk with the blood of the saints and the blood of the martyrs of Jesus," which many scholars take to refer to the firstcentury persecution of Christians by Jewish religious leaders. A few verses later, in 17, the language of eating flesh connotes the destruction of the harlot, which given the interpretation of the previous metaphor of drinking blood, symbolizes the burning of Jerusalem in AD 70.

It's unlikely that Jesus would have intended His command to eat His flesh and drink His blood in order to obtain eternal life to be taken in the metaphorical sense common among Jews, since these words, understood metaphorically by Jews, would have meant, "If you destroy me, you will live forever."

If Jesus were using this language in a different metaphorical sense, He would have made it clear that He was doing so, lest His audience think that He intended the absurd meaning above. Since Jesus doesn't make such a clarification, we can conclude that He is not using the language of eating His flesh and drinking His blood in a metaphorical sense.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONSABOUT ISSUE 1



What is Issue 1?

Issue 1 is a proposed amendment to the Ohio Constitution that would endanger the health and safety of women, threaten parental rights, and allow for abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. Ohioans will vote on November 7, 2023, whether to make this change to the Ohio Constitution.

What would Issue 1 do?

Put women at risk:

 Health and safety standards in Ohio could be eliminated. Doctors could no longer need to examine a woman or explain the risks of the abortion procedure ahead of time.

Threaten parental rights:

• A fifteen-year-old could have an abortion without her parents knowing. Current Ohio law requires parental notification and consent before a child under 18 can obtain an abortion. These parental right protections could be removed as they directly conflict with the amendment which would allow all individuals, including minors, to make their own reproductive decisions.

Allow for abortions of fully formed babies:

 Abortion would be legal through all 9 months of pregnancy. Physicians at an abortion clinic could use a woman's age or emotional well-being as a reason to perform an abortion in the 3rd trimester.

Would abortion be illegal in Ohio if Issue 1 does not pass?

If Issue 1 does not pass, abortion would still be legal in Ohio until a baby's heartbeat can be detected. This standard was challenged in court and placed on hold, allowing for abortions up to 22 weeks as of September 15, 2023. Current laws that protect the safety of women and parental rights would stay in effect.

Doesn't Issue 1 simply restore Ohio back to when Roe v. Wade was in effect?

Issue 1 goes dangerously beyond what was legalized in the Roe v. Wade ruling. It opens the door to remove important health and safety measures that protect women, threatens parental consent and notification of any minor seeking an abortion, and allows for abortion through all nine months of pregnancy.

Will miscarriage care or ectopic pregnancy treatment be denied if Issue 1 fails?

The passing or failure of Issue 1 will have no effect on the care a pregnant woman receives when her life is in danger, even if the treatment results in the loss of life of her unborn child. There is a fundamental difference between an elective abortion and the care provided after a miscarriage. In the case of an ectopic pregnancy, the life-affirming option is to surgically remove the mother's fallopian tube in which the embryo has implanted. No law restricts this care in Ohio or any other state in the country.

How does the Church help pregnant women in need?

For decades, numerous Catholic social service agencies, in collaboration with faith-based and secular organizations, have assisted pregnant women in need with material resources and personal accompaniment during pregnancy and after their child is born. Project Rachel helps those struggling postabortion. Every woman should be able to depend upon a community for support and the Catholic Church remains committed to women in need. 


