

KOLLAR'S CORNER



Dear Parish Community,

We have now entered the Fall season, which is most people's favorite time of the year, with its cool mornings and evenings, 70-degree temperatures and low humidity during the day! As we move into Fall, we can reflect on our eventful summer here at St Brendan, which was filled with projects aimed at keeping our campus functioning well and looking great for years to come.

Recently, our St Brendan's Men's Club and Facilities team collaborated to install the louvered pergola on the plaza next to the Church. This allows parishioners and guests to have an outside space to reflect, pray and enjoy the plants and butterfly garden located nearby.

Our St Brendan Men's Club is an invaluable resource for our parish. They provide men with fellowship through spiritual, social, and fundraising functions such as scheduled monthly meetings and special events. We are also very blessed to have a vibrant Men's Faith Sharing Ministry as well as our Knights of Columbus here at St Brendan, which both help men to stay focused on God, deepen their faith and prioritize their families. RECAP OF OUR COMPLETED SUMMER PROJECTS...

- **1. The new organ** is installed and in use with the addition of an elevated choir platform to conceal wires and eliminate trip hazards.
- 2. The Baptismal pool was extracted and filled in, and the space is now ready for placement of our new Baptismal font. The baptismal font manufacturer plant was struck by lightning which caused damage to the manufacturing equipment used in crafting the font. We are in weekly conversations with them and hopefully will have the font installed by the end of October. When we removed the trip-hazard tile flooring near the font, we had no idea what we would find underneath. After the tiles were removed, it revealed a slight elevation difference to the floor surface. We are investigating options in addressing the transition between the original floor from the first expansion in the mid-90's and our most recent expansion three years ago.
- **3.** The Church interior was repainted to brighten up the ceiling.
- 4. New carpeting was installed throughout the Gathering Space.
- **5.** The main parking lot repairs were completed, although later than expected, due to extreme heat and storms which pushed the project timeline back. We will be sealing the entire lot and re-striping it next year to further protect our investment. We are implementing a 5-year plan to properly repair the parking lot which should then last for years to come.
- **6. Upgraded lighting for First Grade:** We completed installing much needed LED lighting for our First Graders. Two rooms were updated where the 1960's original lighting had become very expensive to maintain. Besides the LED lighting addition, we also lowered the ceilings, which will help focus the lighting onto the students' desks. Studies have shown that this will enhance early development of students' learning capabilities.
- 7. Upgraded Fifth Grade classrooms and hallways: New LVT flooring for both classrooms and hallways was installed to provide better aesthetics, reduce maintenance costs, and improve acoustics for students and teachers. Replacement of cabinetry in the classrooms was completed and is safely providing storage for our teachers for classroom materials. And finally, improved lockers were installed for our Fifth Graders for storing their books and coats.

A special THANKS to our school parents, the support of Home and School, the Leadership Team and our Finance Committee who all collaborated on a variety of school improvements and enrichment projects.

The priests, deacons, parish staff and members of the parish Finance Council believe strongly in being good managers of the finances here in your parish home. We continue to rely on and give thanks for your generosity and support to maintain our campus and welcome your feedback and suggestions as we continue to grow and improve our parish community.

I want to personally thank you all for your birthday well wishes last month. It was a big surprise when my birthday announcement was posted on our St Brendan social media platforms and was a humbling experience that brought a smile to my face. THANK YOU & GOD BLESS... ENJOY YOUR FALL!

BIBLICAL EVIDENCE FOR THE REAL PRESENCE IN THE EUCHARIST (PART 1)

The Catholic Church teaches that at the Last Supper Jesus changed bread and wine into His body and blood with the words, "This is my body....this is my blood." But some still have a hard time with this and wonder if it was intended by Christ to be merely a *symbol* of His body and blood.

There are a few reasons to take Jesus' words literally in the Bread of Life discourse in John 6 where Jesus says, "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me and I in him."

We will look at one obvious one: Jesus' audience understood Him literally, and Jesus doesn't correct them. In verse 52, Jesus' Jewish audience responds. "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus' disciples respond with similar perplexity, "This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?" (v.60)

You would think that if the members of Jesus' audience were mistaken, and given the gravity of this teaching, Jesus would have clarified their taking His words literally. But Jesus does just the opposite: He affirms the literal meaning.

In response to the comments made by His Jewish audience, Jesus reiterates the need to eat His flesh and drink His blood no less than six times in six verses (vv.53-58). He likewise affirms His disciples' literal interpretation when He allows them to walk away because of their refusal to accept His teaching (v. 66).

If Jesus were using this language in a different metaphorical sense, He would have made it clear that He was doing so, lest His audience think that He intended the absurd meaning above. Since Jesus doesn't make such a clarification, we can conclude that He is not using the language of eating His flesh and drinking His blood in a metaphorical sense.
