I wish others knew that Jesus is truly present in the mass, and the Holy Spirit is truly alive as well, and that Mass shouldn't be seen as an obligation but as an opportunity to grow closer and closer to His sacred heart every time we enter in." -Andrew, senior

"To consume the Eucharist is a physical way of consuming God's love and sacrifice for His children. My heart overflows with His love when I consume the Eucharist and He wants the same for you." -Anna, junior

"The Eucharist for me is a taste of what it's going to be like in Heaven." -Austin, sophomore

My prayer for our parish is that the same way these teens have spent time in the presence of Jesus and been transformed by His love, that we would follow their lead and do the same. Jesus is waiting to meet YOU in the Adoration chapel and at Mass. There is nothing more important than spending time with Him!



HOW TO PRAY THE OPENING PRAYER

Spiritual Meaning: "Sacrifice," which is at the heart of Jesus' saving work, the Mass and the Christian life, means giving undivided love to God the Father. Gifts and offerings that truly represent the heart of the giver are the true sacrifice desired by God. The objective of the preparation of the gifts and of the altar is to place our whole selves on the altar so that we can be joined with Jesus' whole self and given to God the Father.

Participation: Pray the Morning Offering throughout the week, and during the preparation of the altar and the gifts at Mass, consider slowly and thoughtfully what or whom you pray for: what you are working toward in the days to come; what has brought you recent joy, and each thing large or small that causes you pain or suffering. Be specific and genuine in these considerations and place them on the altar along with the bread and wine.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Spiritual Meaning: A priest is a bridge builder, or pontifex, who bridges the divide separating Man from God so that we can pass over from earth to heaven. Jesus' priestly Paschal Mystery – His suffering, death, Resurrection, and Ascension – bridges the gap between fallen earth and eternal heaven: He is the Pontifex Maximus. Even though Christ does not need our assistance in His saving work, He makes us sharers in His priesthood at Baptism, empowering us to build the Paschal bridge with Him during the Eucharistic Prayer.

Participation: Recalling that Baptism conforms us to Jesus and His priesthood and gives to each the power to offer sacrifice, following the preparation of your heart during the offertory prayers, remember that you must join these to the sacrifice of Jesus at the priest's hands, sending them across the chasm to God the Father.



GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

When we think of gifts, we may picture a child eagerly ripping into wrapping paper on a birthday or at Christmas. Oh, the anticipation and the joy seen through a child's eyes! In contemplating today's Scriptures, it occurs to me that the gifts God has given to us should fill us with the same joy and sense of gratitude as that child. Although there are many facets to the parable of the talents which Jesus tells his disciples in today's Gospel, what stands out to me comes at the very beginning: "A man going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them." No small thing to be entrusted with the master's possessions! In the same way, God entrusts us with his gifts - they are all we have and all we are. And, like the master in the parable, God expects us to use our gifts and talents to build his kingdom here on earth - to multiply his goodness in the world.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Does the parable seem a bit harsh at the end? After all, the last servant didn't squander the money he was given, he simply gave it back in the same form in which it was given to him. But let's think about our generous God and the gifts and talents he has given us. God expects us to use these gifts, not hide them under a bushel. If we are lazy with and inattentive to our God-given gifts, they will shrink and fade away. We will be squandering our invitation to full participation in the kingdom of God. Obviously, each of God's children has unique gifts, just as the servants in the parable received different numbers of talents according to their ability. With this in mind, let us consider how we can share our singular gifts and help others do the same. No gift or talent is too small, and God has given us everything we need to use each gift wisely. Empowered by God's love and grace, let us use our blessings for his glory.

WITNESS The imagery of the "wicked, lazy" servant being punished, coupled with St. Paul's words that the Lord will come "like a thief at night," impart urgency to the task before us. In order to be prepared to give God an accounting of how we are using his gifts, let us start growing them today. Offer forgiveness, love someone whom it is hard to love, show mercy; in other words, be a blessing to others and see how that goodness multiplies.


