A MESSAGE FROM FR STINNETT

### Your Gift to Jesus this Christmas

Our journey through Advent looks forward to the coming of Christ at Christmas, the first coming of Christ, the miracle of the Incarnation and Jesus' birth to Mary and Joseph in the stable in Bethlehem, the Word-Made-Flesh. However, there are two other senses in which Advent is a time of preparation for the coming of Jesus. The second is the coming



of Christ at the end of time, when He will gather all creation together in Himself. In between these two, there is another "advent," another coming of Christ. It is not as though Jesus abandoned us at the Ascension, leaving us to our own devices until He returns. Some days it may feel this way, especially with all the negative news coverage that our country and our Church receives. Just as Jesus was born in the dark of night and cold of winter, Jesus is present to His Church even in the darkness of the world and the seeming lack of the warmth of love.

Jesus is present in His Church, and especially in the hearts of believers who open their lives to Him. This happens in a real way in the sacraments. At our Baptism, we were washed in Jesus' Death and Resurrection. With original sin wiped away, we were made a fit dwelling place for God. St Therese of Lisieux says, "Our Lord does not come down from Heaven every day to lie in a golden ciborium. He comes to find another Heaven which is infinitely dearer to Him—the Heaven of our souls, created in His image, the living temples of the adorable Trinity." Jesus tells us this at the Last Supper: "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him" (Jn 14:23). Our heart is the place where this middle coming of Jesus takes place. It is where He desires to dwell more than anywhere else.

In Advent, we are called upon in a special way to prepare our hearts once again to be the place of the coming of Jesus. This is why Advent is a penitential season as well as a season of preparation. We do so much to decorate our homes for Christmas. We need to take time to decorate our hearts, as well. This is done by taking extra time for prayer, maybe a day or two of fasting, and confessing those sins which prevent Jesus from taking up residence in our heart. We do penance to open ourselves to God's mercy and God's presence in our lives. The absolution received in Confession restores our souls to the same state of perfection they were in on the day of our Baptism, and even more so, because we bring with it all the good works, the virtues, and the merits we have received over the course of our life. This should be our present to the baby Jesus on Christmas Day, a spiritual bouquet of prayers, good works, and the sincere resolve to live out the holiness to which He calls us and by Whose grace it is possible to achieve.



### A PARISHIONER'S TESTIMONIAL

I am an office volunteer on Thursdays (my favorite day of the week,) doing odds and ends for the staff. I truly enjoy my role, and during my time I have the honor of being an adorer for one hour before I go into the office... It is such a gift!

I had recently attended the Buckeye Awakening retreat at OSU and cried that entire Holy Hour when Jesus was exposed during Adoration. I cried so hard I got a headache and needed Advil after. The monstrance was the most beautiful thing I'd ever seen! A couple months prior, while in a non-Catholic Bible Study, the leader had talked about trembling and shaking before the Lord. I had done exactly that during my time with Jesus at the Buckeye Awakening! I then started going to our parish Holy Hour and loved listening to the music but could not seem to focus in the silence. I didn't want to rely on others to drive me multiple times a week to the parish to just "sit in silence" for an hour and had the mind-set that "Jesus is everywhere... I don't need Adoration to pray." But in the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus says to Peter, "so you couldn't watch with me for one hour?" The King of the Universe is asking us, for just one hour out of our busy schedules, to sit with Him.

When I started volunteering back in the fall, Jen Rice asked me if I wanted to fill the need of being an adorer. I thought, great, I can kill two birds with one stone. I know that Jesus wanted to see me and spoke through Jen. I gave my "yes" but was apprehensive if I could focus. This time, I didn't struggle at all that hour in silence, thank you Jesus! We live in a world that is filled with so much noise and in the Adoration chapel there is complete silence. I feel so much peace in that one hour and don't view it as an hour of sitting in silence now. It's an hour of talking to my Father, receiving affirmation about myself and what's on my mind. The saints want to meet you there as well. It's now my favorite hour of the week.

If you can't commit one hour, Jesus still loves you and wants you. If you are ever at the parish besides Mass, I encourage you to go to the chapel. No time is too short or too long for Jesus, He is outside of time. No matter if it's a quick hello, or thirty minutes or more, He sees you. He loves to see His children. Imagine being an empty nester and your child comes home unexpectedly. That's who you are to Jesus! He is so joyful to see you!



### Second Sunday of Advent

Is 40:1-5, 9-11 | 2 Pt 3:8-14 | Mk 1:1-8

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Can you hear it? The voice crying out in the desert? While John the Baptist was the one literally proclaiming, from the desert, the coming of the Lord, we should listen for echoes of his message today. John foretold that Jesus - the Father's Incarnate Son was on his way to redeem the world. Through Jesus' passion and death, the gates of heaven were flung open so all who believe in him would have eternal life. This is the Good News he proclaimed then, and the Church proclaims today: Christ has come! Christ has died, Christ is risen, and Christ will come again. This is what we prepare for in Advent - to celebrate, on Christmas day, Christ's coming into the world, and that he will one day return in glory. The Lord gives comfort to his people in his words, and in his presence to us in the Eucharist: "According to his promise we await new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells." So, trust in the Lord, remain vigilant, and take heed of the voices that remind us to "prepare the way of the Lord."

### GO EVANGELIZE

### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Each year, we are given the gift of Advent. It is a season that invites us to slow down, reflect on the gift of Jesus and prepare to celebrate the Nativity of the Lord. Ironically, though, it happens at one of the most frenzied times of the year as we rush to keep up with cookie baking, tree decorating and merrymaking. Advent is short - it includes four Sundays but can be three to four weeks long depending on the weekday upon which Christmas falls - and it sometimes doesn't seem long enough to truly prepare our hearts. This year Advent is three weeks and a day - so we are close to reaching the midway point, which is a good time to ask ourselves: How tuned in are we to John the Baptist's message? If we feel like we're being carried along in a wave of consumerism, it's not too late to make a course correction. We can step away from the fray and carve out time to enjoy the stillness of Advent and truly listen to the voice crying out in the desert.




