A MESSAGE FROM FR BOB

"You have nothing to fear... Today in David's city, a Savior has been born."

Dear Parish Family,

This Christmas, we are conscious that we are forever changed by the events of the last few months. As we enter into the Christmas season of goodwill and feasting, the media ensures that we carry the situation in the Holy Land with us. War continues to rage in Ukraine and there are signs of unrest across the world. Christians are persecuted more and more and the thought of Christmas joy is bleak for many.

But what a joy it is to hear those words from Luke's Gospel. They reassure us as we listen to the good news of Christ's birth. The angel's message, spoken down through the ages to each one of us, calls us from our anxiety and conflict and draws us into a sense of guiet wonder, as the glory of God's peace breaks again into our lives.

In the Christmas story, as Christ takes on human flesh for our salvation, we see a little more clearly the powerful hand of God guiding and directing human history. Seeing this, we can all be reassured, for no matter how much our world is turned upside down, God in Jesus remains faithful and true.

When chaos seems to rage all around us, we are reminded that though God has called us, humankind has often chosen not to accept that call, chosen not to listen. And so, the world of God's design was shattered. Human beings chose to live rather in a world of their own making. Isaiah reminds us that for thousands of years people walked in darkness. Sadly, many still do.

But the darkness did not last. It never does. It never can. Even as the world seems to slip into chaos, we are reminded that God the Father breathed forth His Spirit, and sent it to settle on the world, to once again from chaos form and draw together a people chosen to be His own.

But this time, it was not a people created in the image of God. This time, God chose to take on human flesh so that for all eternity, God's own life might bear a human face. And so it happened. God's creating Word was spoken again. The Spirit was sent to hover this time over a single woman, and through her over every age of humankind. This was the most that God could give. This was the fullness of gift, the fullness of grace. Never again in this life can humanity completely withdraw from the presence of God. God is Incarnate. God has taken on human flesh, and the imprint of the divine presence is to be found in every human face.

God speaks with a human tongue, God touches us with human hands, and God loves us with a sacred heart. It is now we, who are the messengers, who must repeat this Christmas call to one another. Now, once again, with a sense of urgency at the end of a traumatic year, we must summon one another with these words,

"Don't be afraid... I have good news for you. God is with us."

Never again need we be trapped in the darkness. We have been promised - God is with us. The good news has been proclaimed - the Savior has been born. God's favor does rest on us, and there is the promise of peace on earth.

Wishing you a blessed and holy Christmas season!




