A MESSAGE FROM MAGGIE AGRA

Happy first day of Advent!

Advent is a particularly special time to me, as I love preparing and organizing for big celebrations. However, beyond the endless Christmas parties, deadlines, and to-do lists, Advent is more so a time to focus on the preparation of our hearts for the great gift of Christmas. On Christmas, we celebrate the reality of the Incarnation. Some call this event, "The Scandal of the Incarnation," because it so wildly reveals God's great humility and love for His people. God so loves us that He became as low as a human, born in a manger, to proclaim that love to us. Not only did He become human 2,000 years ago in Bethlehem, but He also gave us the great gift of the Eucharist to consume whenever we come to Mass!



We can see the ways that the Lord was foreshadowing and pointing to the Eucharist through the Christmas story. The name "Bethlehem," the small country town in which Jesus was born, translates from the Old Hebrew as "House of Bread." Jesus is the Bread of Life, the Eucharist! And when Jesus was born, as a small, helpless newborn, He was placed gently in a manger. A manger, as many of us know, is no glamorous cradle that we find in the baby section of Target. A manger is actually a feeding trough for animals. We feed on the Eucharist at every Mass.


From the very beginning of His earthly life, the Lord was pointing to the fact that He would be our sustenance in this life. Even the fact that Jesus was humbly born as a baby points us back to the Eucharist. He came as something small, fragile, and relatable. This is also found in the Eucharist - a small host, easily broken, and relating to us by appearing as bread. Jesus was even wrapped in swaddling clothes the same way that shepherds would swaddle lambs for the sacrificial offering in the Temple.

There are so many beautiful ways that the Lord points us to the Eucharist through the Advent and Christmas celebrations. This Advent season, I encourage you to truly pray and enter into the Advent season as a preparation for the joy of the Incarnation and the gift of the Eucharist.

EXTEND A SPECIAL INVITATION TO SOMEONE THIS ADVENT

While we are deepening our own devotion to the Eucharist in this season of Eucharistic Revival, we should also be looking externally to how we can live as sons and daughters and bring the Good News to others. In the third phase of the Revival, the focus will be on missionary sending – going out into the world, not just to be an example, but to bring others with us to the table of our Lord.

We have an ideal opportunity to bring our family and friends to the Christmas table. We often see family come to Mass on Christmas, even when they have not been participating during the year. For some it is tradition, for others, family obligation. Whatever the reason that brings them into the doors, this is the opportunity to perhaps have them stay with the faith beyond Christmas.



This Advent we encourage each of you to intentionally invite one family member or friend back to the Church at Christmas. Keep it simple and welcoming: this is a time for gathering together in celebration of the greatest and most unimaginable



gift, and their attendance at Mass is a way to celebrate with you, to give thanks for the blessings God has bestowed in this year.

First, pray about whom you would like to invite; then give them a call, see them in person, or use one of the cards we have created just for this purpose in the gathering space (shown to the left). Bring one more to the table and let Jesus do the rest!

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In a nineteenth-century sermon, St. John Henry Newman wrote of today's Gospel: "[Jesus] mercifully whispers into our ears ... not to share in the general unbelief [around us], not to be carried away by the world but to 'beware, keep alert' and look out for his coming." I love the thought that Jesus is "mercifully whispering" to us. Welcome to Advent! We know that Advent is a time of anticipation and preparing our hearts for the coming of Christ, but today's readings also speak to me of training ourselves to be alert for God's presence in the small, everyday moments of our lives. In his Letter to the Corinthians, Paul writes that "[we] are not lacking in any spiritual gift" as we await the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are gifted with his grace. Our loving God bestows countless graces on us each day, and with the help of the Holy Spirit we can seek ways to be more aware of these graces. Yes, we can be more "alert" to them, but can also be thankful for these small moments of God's presence with us.

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Advent is a season of joyful hope. "I hope I can get my Christmas shopping done in time ... I hope I have time to get my house decorated this weekend." We all have "hopes and dreams" for this time of year, and, God-willing we will be blessed with a truly festive and joyous holiday season with our families. For Catholics, though, this season of "joyful hope" is one that has a much deeper meaning. We long for the return of Christ and our eternal union with him with a hope that is built on the promises of Jesus in the Scriptures. Our hope is not passive, but active. We know that God is always there for us, comforting us in bad times and rejoicing with us in times of happiness. Let us give thanks for our Triune God who desires to be in relationship with us enough that he sent his Son to take on our humanity. And let us silence any noise in our hearts so as to hear Jesus' merciful whisper of encouragement to be on the watch for his coming.
