

A MESSAGE FROM JACOB DORAN

Through 2023, I listened and read along with the Catechism In A Year Podcast. In its final section, the Catechism of the Catholic Church walks through and teaches the meaning of each petition of the Our Father. I was particularly struck with paragraph 2816, which says, "The Kingdom of God lies ahead of us. It is brought near in the Word incarnate, it is proclaimed throughout the whole Gospel, and it has come in Christ's Death and Resurrection. The Kingdom of God has been coming since the Last



Supper and, in the Eucharist, it is in our midst. The Kingdom will come in glory when Christ hands it over to his Father..." As I write this note a few days after Christmas, this teaching reminds me of the ways that Christ comes to us, much like what Jen Rice wrote about in her note a few weeks ago. Christ came to Mary and Joseph on the First Christmas, He comes to us in our hearts through the Sacraments, and He will come again at the end of time.

Currently, we live in the age of the New Covenant. In this era, the Holy Spirit is poured out upon us in Baptism and sealed in us at Confirmation. By His Holy Spirit, Jesus Himself lives in us, bringing us into the Kingdom of God. Because of His presence in our souls, we have a duty and role in bringing about His kingdom to the world. The Catechism also teaches us that because God has given us the opportunity for life forever with Him, we are responsible for bringing the justice and peace of God's Kingdom to the society we live in now. The power to do this comes repeatedly through the grace of the Eucharist which enables us to live according to the characteristics of a citizen of the Kingdom of God: The Beatitudes.

The perfect example of spreading the Kingdom of God and living out the Beatitudes is our recent high school mission trip to Crank's Creek. The youth were able to serve and pray with over 600 families and make more home visits than ever before. On the same trip, they also participated in Holy Mass and Eucharistic Adoration. The presence of Christ in the Eucharist always commits us to the presence of Christ in the poor. When you think about how to bring about the Kingdom of God, think of this.

And so, we have a mission and a means by which we can evaluate our success. The more that we live according to the Beatitudes, the more that through us the Holy Spirit is bringing about the Kingdom of God. We should let this kingdom be present in our everyday lives, in our daily prayer, and in our every action. We can bring the Kingdom of God into our family, our work, and to our loved ones. This can be accomplished by being merciful and compassionate. You and I are representatives and envoys to this kingdom. Where the Kingdom of God is proclaimed, Christ is present there. For Jesus is truly Emmanuel, God with us.

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. – John 1:14

Something transformative and deeply satisfying happens when we receive the Eucharist: we receive Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in every microscopic particle of the Consecrated Host or Precious Blood. He is an invited guest. He comes to dwell within us. And not only within our souls but within our bodies too, our good, made-by-God bodies.

He comes to dwell to fill our every need, our every desire, our every unknown and unseen ache. Of course, He knows and sees them. He made us, after all, one inner stitch at a time (Psalm 138:13). He knows the hairs on our head (Luke 12:7), the longings of our heart (Psalm 38:9), the embarrassing, the ugly, the pangs of shame (1 Peter 5:7) and loves us still (Romans 5:8). We are His, all of us.

He comes not merely to tamp down the geyser of never being enough, but also to patch over the black hole of never doing enough.

He comes as the Divine Healer of our bodies and our souls. He doesn't just want us to feel better. He wants us to be transformed through Him, with Him, and in Him. And that is what His dwelling within us does. We become more like Him.

What does it mean to become more like Him? What does our identity look like already? What will change?

Jesus comes to dwell within us, with His Body and Soul inside our body and soul. He fills every creaky dip and smooths every cracked edge. He brings deep and abiding peace with Him. He is the delight and contentment of true, lasting satisfaction.

He is the only One Who will satisfy. Let Him come dwell within you.



The Epiphany of the Lord

Is 60:1-6 | Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6 | Mt 2:1-12

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

It's interesting how an event can be interpreted by different people. God's revelation of himself in the birth of the child Jesus is clearly one such event. The Magi, Gentiles from the east, had heard of this "newborn king of the Jews" and undertook a long and arduous journey to see him and offer him homage. They were edified and eager in their search. Herod, himself a king - of the Jews - did not have the same reaction. The very thought of this "newborn king" threatened him and filled him with rage and suspicion. In this moment in human history, the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles (i.e., the Epiphany) unveils the truth of God's redemptive work for all of creation to be reconciled to himself. This truth has been accepted and rejected throughout time, and our celebration of this feast gives us an opportunity to give thanks in a focused and particular way for our acceptance of it - to give thanks for the gift of our faith. Perhaps it is even a moment for us to have our own, colloquial epiphany: an "aha moment," where we once again truly understand the depth of God's love for us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The Magi, the Gentiles from the east, were changed after their encounter with the Christ Child; they were warned not to return to Herod and they obeyed and took a different route home. In today's second reading, St. Paul says it has been revealed that Gentiles are "coheirs, members of the same body" - the body of Christ. Just as the magi were forever changed by their journey, so must we be. Their journey is a model for us, but we do not have to seek Christ in the world as they did; he is here with us, in Word and in the Eucharist.
