

### **RETURN TO HIM...**

"Yet even now - return to me with your whole heart."

These words of the Lord through the prophet Joel are instructions to us with a twofold meaning this year. We will begin Lent this week with the spiritual goal of repentance, to clear away anything that is keeping us away from a relationship with our Lord, to grow stronger in prayer and in generosity to others. God is asking us to return to Him in this season – whether we are already with Him or have turned away, returning means re-turn. Do it again, with even more effort. Come into relationship with your whole heart.

How fitting that this verse also corresponds to where we are in the Eucharistic Revival. Jesus is asking each of us to return to Him by spending time in His presence at Mass, in Adoration, in prayer. He wants our whole heart's attention to believe in His true presence in the Eucharist. He knows what this will mean for not just our spiritual lives, but for all of our environments and all whom we encounter. More grace, less struggle – even in the suffering.

That is why, this Lent in particular, so many of our offerings are built around Jesus in the Eucharist so we may have an actionable way to re-turn to Him with our whole hearts. We will add Monday nights to our Adoration hours and will have more hours during Holy Week as we lead up to the Triduum. Our parish mission, March 4-6, Listen-Adore-Learn, are 3 very different nights of deepening our faith and understanding of Jesus. Msgr Frank Lane will be here first to speak to us about the Eucharist as Thanksgiving. On March 5, we welcome a nationallyknown music and worship group for a *True Presence* Night with Adoration, witness and music. Then, on March 6, Father Bob and Father Jacob will provide a *Teaching Mass* – actual Mass with commentary on what is happening and how we respond. This will take your Mass participation to the next level!

We are also offering the program, *Jesus and the Eucharist*, provided by the *National Eucharistic Revival* in seven Tuesday morning or evening sessions. Videos and small group discussion offer great content and the opportunity to hear from bishops, Catholic speakers, and each other. All teens and adults are welcome to register and attend.

Our prayer for you this Lent is that you embrace this season not with dread, but with excitement about what is possible as you intentionally re-turn to our Lord. Check out our Lent page on the website for even more ideas you can do on your own. Jesus is waiting to welcome you into His presence, for His love and generosity knows no bounds. We just need to make that first move and turn.


