A MESSAGE FROM FR WELDIT

THE SACRAMENT OF: CONVERSION, PENANCE, CONFESSION, FORGIVENESS, RECONCILIATION



Changing our mind is a conversion of our life. A commander told his troops to get ready to defeat the enemies around him, and his troops, armed with their available weapons, got ready. The commander vowed to destroy his enemies. Later, he went alone to the place where his enemies were and defeated them. not through force, but peacefully and lovingly without harming them. He then returned back

to his place. His army was amazed, remembering that he had said he would defeat them. He said, "You see how I have defeated all my enemies? Now I have no enemies." He explained how he had defeated his enemies, converting them from enemies into friends through peace and love.

This week, our parish has a scheduled Penance Service on Tuesday, March 19, 7-9 PM, in preparation for Easter. This is an invitation, and opportunity that God shows us His love. He loves us and died for our sins. Through Him, we have forgiveness of our sins, conversion, and a new life that allows us to be God's holy people – our common vocation that God instilled within us on the day of our Baptism.

In the Catechism of Catholic Church (CCC 1423-1424) it states the following about the Sacrament of Reconciliation:

- It is called the *Sacrament of Conversion* because it makes sacramentally present Jesus' call to conversion, the first step in returning to the Father from Whom one has strayed by sin.
- It is called the Sacrament of Penance, since it consecrates the Christian sinner's personal and ecclesial steps of conversion, penance, and satisfaction.
- It is called the Sacrament of Confession, since the disclosure or confession of sins to a priest is an essential element of this sacrament. In a profound sense, it is also a "confession" acknowledgment and praise of the holiness of God and of His mercy toward sinful man.
- It is called the *Sacrament of Forgiveness*, since by the priest's sacramental absolution God grants the penitent "pardon and peace."
- It is called the Sacrament of Reconciliation, because it imparts to the sinner the love of God who reconciles: "Be reconciled to God." He who lives by God's merciful love is ready to respond to the Lord's call: "Go; first be reconciled to your brother."

The purpose of conversion is preparing for the celebration of the Paschal Triduum – This is a time for self-discovery, to reexamine our lives and to confront ourselves with the Truth of the Gospel. It is a time to pause and evaluate our relationship with God, to make amends, and to correct the course of our lives. When we pray, we are in permanent dialogue with God. When we do almsgiving, we express our caring for the poor and orphaned, the hurt and those in need of our care. During this time, we are on a path of purification and openness to the love of God and open to transformation. Conversion is the transformation of our lives where we no longer live according to the world's standards, but according to the faith we have received. The moral values instilled through our faith allow us to live according to God's will.

In the Gospel of Matthew 18:1-5, Jesus reminds us: "Unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of Heaven." We take from this verse that conversion is essential to enter Heaven. Conversion means a turning point. We repent from sin and change our lives to live according to Jesus' teachings. There is no true conversion without repentance of sin. Conversion will lead to transformation, which will happen over time. We become more aware of our own impurity, corruption, and the evil in the world. It becomes easier to recognize the Holy Spirit's signs around us and we become more prompt to reject sin and embrace goodness.

Let us be reconciled during this Holy Lent – with God, with our neighbor, and with ourselves – through the mystery of penance. Our enemy, Satan, is often around us and causes hatred – with God, with our neighbor, with ourselves, and with our church. But God calls us, always invites us back, through the Church, through repentance, to walk with Him on the way to the cross on a path of conversion and self-discovery. Therefore, let us prepare our heart and examine our conscience for conversion during this time leading up to our Parish Penance Service this week. In this Penance Service, let us be reconciled with God through repentance in preparation for the Resurrection of Christ so that, like the apostles and through the power of the Holy Spirit, we can then go forth and proclaim the Gospel to others, that Christ is Risen!

What changes do we need to make within ourselves during this conversion to center on God? This question is a personal reflection we need to undergo in order to transform our relationship with Jesus so that we can live out the Gospel message more fully.

As a result, living the Gospel will turn us into missionary disciples, enabling us to share with others what the Lord has done in our lives.



Fifth Sunday of Lent

Jer 31:31-34 | Heb 5:7-9 | Jn 12:20-33

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

As we quickly approach Easter, we're reminded of the reason why we are celebrating. God's chosen people stumbled quite a bit throughout the Old Testament, so God intervened time, and time, and time again to set them back on the straight and narrow. Whereas we would likely give up on someone over time, God has remained steadfast in his grace, and always will. He created a new covenant with Israel that wrote his law upon the hearts of Jews and Gentiles alike. This new covenant was realized through Jesus Christ, who was born into our flesh and crucified on the cross. He suffered death in perfect obedience to God the Father. By being born into flesh, Jesus united humanity and divinity; through his crucifixion and resurrection, Christ "became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him." He is the law of love that lives within us, and through him "all, from least to greatest, shall know [the Father.]"

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Jesus didn't suffer the cross for his sake or for his own glory. No, our Savior came to preach the kingdom of heaven to us before sacrificing himself for our sins. Notice how in today's Gospel he even admitted he was troubled! It can be terrifying to do God's will for our lives, and Christ himself was troubled by what he was called to do. Yet, in love and trust in the Father, Jesus was obedient, saying "but it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name." All Christians are called to a life of self-sacrifice, each to the degree it serves God's purpose. We are all called to give up our lives for the sake of love to glorify God. Without Christ's sacrifice, we would not have been saved; without our willingness to pursue God's call upon our life, the kingdom of God cannot be realized on this earth.






