### A MESSAGE FROM JACOB DORAN



This time of year, many of our parish youth are celebrating their First Eucharist and Confirmation. These are both Sacraments of Initiation, which mark our full entrance into the Church. In particular, Confirmation completes Baptism and strengthens the graces and gifts given by the Holy Spirit.

What I have reflected on about the Sacraments is that as we celebrate them, we make a lifelong commitment to God. This is probably most obvious in Baptism, Marriage, or Holy Orders, but also in First Eucharist and Confirmation as well.


In First Eucharist, we commit to a life of grace fueled by the Eucharist. We live out this commitment by attending the Mass on Sundays or more to bring our own prayers and needs to the Eucharistic sacrifice. We also have the opportunity to receive and encounter again Jesus Christ in His Body and Blood.

In Confirmation, we commit to a life on mission with the Holy Spirit and the Church. This sacrament is often confused as to be a ceremony or kind of graduation. Yet, like the Eucharist is an encounter with Jesus Christ, Confirmation is an encounter with the Holy Spirit. He stirs up in us what was begun at Baptism and seals our souls with the mark of a Christian.

Please continue to pray for all who are celebrating or have celebrated these powerful sacraments this year! (See pg 6 for the names of those confirmed April 26)

#### **SUMMER SCRIPTURE STUDY**

Ephesians was one of the most widely circulated of St Paul's writings because of its powerful, practical instructions for disciples of Christ. In fact, its six short chapters contain some of the most discussed passages in the New Testament. Ephesians: Discover Your Inheritance examines many important themes that are still relevant in today's Christian culture and society—the nature of marriage, the purpose and role of the Church, the preeminence of grace in God's plan, and the reality of spiritual warfare.



Presenter Jeff Cavins explores what Paul's letter to the Ephesians tells us about the nature of the Church—as a body, a household, a mystery, a communion, a bride, and an army. *Ephesians: Discover Your Inheritance* shows the treasures that await us as adopted sons and daughters in the family of God.





### Fifth Sunday of Easter

Acts 9:26-31 | 1 Jn 3:18-24 | Jn 15:1-8

#### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"Where do they get their energy!" Maybe you've said that about your children as they run around the yard while you're trying to wrangle them inside for bedtime. Jokes abound about how sugar and caffeine are what keep most adults going, but we know it's proper nutrition, exercise, and rest that enable us to do well whatever it is we do. That is all relevant to us physically. What about spiritually? Bishop Barron, writing on the Gospel, says. "Jesus declares that he is the vine and we are the branches. He is the power and energy source in which we live." (Word on Fire Bible, 548) Just as we see the effects of sugar and caffeine on people, we see the super-natural effects of Jesus' love on, and in, people. As he nurtures us with his perfect love, and that flows into us who are grafted onto him, it changes us. It transforms us and converts us away from sin and toward God. We fill up on that spiritual fuel in the sacramental life of the Church and become a witness to it in how we go about our days - loving one another.

#### GO EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

"Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth." These words from John in our second reading provide the perfect bridge between the ministry of Paul, about whom we heard in the first reading, and Christ's message in the Gospel. With Jesus as "the power and energy source in which we live," we not only can profess the truth, but live it. We not only give our own account of Christ working in us, as Paul did, who came to them speaking out "boldly in the name of the Lord," but we stand beside one an-other, as Barnabas did, vouching for Paul to the Apostles. We are united in baptism, in love, in profession of faith, and in communion with one another. When we consistently act in a Christian manner toward others and keep God's commandments, John says, we "re-main in him, and he in [us], and the way we know that he remains in us is from the Spirit he gave us." In other words, those who remain in Christ "will bear much fruit" - a tangible sign that easily answers the question, "where does he/she get her energy?"

**PRAY** Is there anything in your life that is an obstacle to Jesus being the power and energy source in which you live? Are your days fueled more by anger, frustration, or ambition than his love? Pray this week in thanksgiving to God for where he has given you conversion of heart, and ask him for the grace to see where improvement is needed and the will to make it happen.






